Jeffrey Brand has not heard back from David LaPorte yet. Jeffrey Brand also stated that he will look into reaching out to Swampscott Highschool to inquire if they have any clubs or departments that would be interested in making the wooden benches as part of a project.
- Jill Susarrey asked the other COD members' for permission to write a letter in support of the Swampscott Council on Aging's purchase of an electric, wheelchair-accessible vehicle through the FY 24 Community Transit Grant Program. The COD members then voted unanimously in support of this letter as it would also be of benefit and use to disabled members of our community. It was then decided that the COD would meet again on December 22, 2023 at 9:30 a.m. to vote to officially approve the letter to be written by Jill Susarrey.
- Lauren Shrestha provided an update on our goal of having the new addition to the Abbott Park playground fully fenced-in/enclosed. Lauren stated that she has yet to hear back from Marzie Galazka with any proposals or updates on where the fencing project stands. Mary Ellen Fletcher, Swampscott Select Board member and Select Board liase for the COD, then volunteered to reach out to Gino Cresta Jr. (Director of Public Works and Assistant Town Administrator, Operations for the Town of Swampscott) to try to get an update on the project, as Marzie Galazka said she was working with Gino on this project.
