- 1. August 11, 2020 Minutes: Sierra made, Richard seconded, and the Committee unanimously approved a motion to adopt the August 11, 2020 minutes.
- 2. School Building Committee:
 - Group discussed the School Building options as it relates to Open Space and Recreation and 9 priorities were identified:
 - No loss of open space in Swampscott (i.e. If Stanley option is chosen, Hadley is converted to open space)
 - Prioritize reduction of environmental impact through energy efficiency
 - Maximize square footage of outdoor space/play area per student (as well as through construction period)
 - Playground preservation at Hadley site
 - Sustainable transportation: preference for walkability and busing
 - Factor in costs, financial & environmental, to building in close proximity to wetlands (i.e. Middle School)
 - Factor in costs of disrupting recreation facilities (i.e. tennis courts)
 - Prioritize sites that maximize outdoor and environmental education in existing open spaces (woods, ocean, nature trails, etc)
 - Consider with construction: outdoor classrooms, green roof, organic lawns, school gardens, natural playscapes, porous parking lots
