Old Business:- A brief discussion of the success of the 100<sup>th</sup> Birthday Party took place. Alyce reported that the caterer fed 400 people on the day of the event. Everyone seemed pleased with the event and determined that it ~~a~~was a success.

New Business- John Karwowski announced that he will be resigning as a member of the board. He will be moving out of state and will no longer be eligible to be on the board. The trustees suggested some names as possible replacement until the end of John's term in April. The board decided that they will submit Tript Sembhi's names as a replacement to this position. John has been on the Board of Trustees for 12 years.
