The meeting was scheduled to have the members present to discuss creating an earlier time table for the Capital Improvement Plan to be completed than following years. The committee also discussed with Ron Mendes regarding the U-Mass Collins Center budget and financial plan for capital improvement. The Collins Center's aim is to enable public entities to provide high quality services to the people they serve on a sustainable basis. The Collins Center will work with the town, our financial team, and department leaders to complete a capital needs assessment and develop a capital investment strategy. The Collins Center will help Town Leadership develop a comprehensive, five-year plan that Swampscott can afford. The development of a comprehensive, five-year capital improvement plan (CIP) is one of the most important responsibilities of municipal leaders. It allows for the effective and fiscally-responsible management of capital assets and infrastructure.
