We briefly spoke about the 911 Registration forms:

The first letter will be written by Jim and Rupinder. This letter will address the issues surrounding the crosswalks and the detectable warning pads on Maple street. Jim will talk about his personal experiences.

This letter will address the water pipes blocking the police station. The bullet points of this letter are: Pipes going across the sidewalks and the entrance to the police station the gravel covering it, which a chair can not get over no barriers or accessible detours
