2. Traffic & Parking Regulatory Requests – items to be reviewed by the Committee in order to provide a recommendation to the Board of Selectmen.
  - a. No Parking Here to Corner (Swampscott Road at Paradise Road) – Request by LT. THOMAS STEPHENS to restrict on-street parking on Swampscott Road near the intersection with Paradise Road to improve visibility for drivers.
  - b. No Parking on One Side of Street (Elmwood Road from Thomas Road to Paradise Road) – Request by LT. THOMAS STEPHENS to restrict one side of Elmwood Road to “No Parking” due to limited travel lane widths.
  - c. MBTA Bus Stop Improvement (Salem Street at Humphrey Street) – Request by MBTA (via Stantec) to review the planned bus stop and pedestrian crossing improvements at the bus stop located on Salem Street near the Humphrey Street intersection.
  - d. No Standing or Drop-Off (Puritan Road at Johnson Park) – Request by KEN STOLL to add additional signage/painting to ensure drivers do not block visibility of pedestrians in crosswalk (between Phillips Park and Johnson Park) when dropping off people at the side of the road next to Johnson Park.
