### AGENDA

1. Review and approve minutes from previous meeting(s).
2. Traffic & Parking Regulatory Requests – items to be reviewed by the Committee in order to provide a recommendation to the Board of Selectmen.
  - a. Recommendation for Intersection Change (Humphrey Street & Atlantic Avenue) – Request by I SABENA (via SeeClickFix) to consider a change to the intersection to improve traffic traveling north on Humphrey Street. The recommendations include: 1) a sign alerting motorists that Humphrey Street is a left turn, 2) Move the existing traffic lights at the intersection of Puritan Road and Humphrey Street to the Humphrey Street and Atlantic Avenue intersection (or place additional traffic lights on the corner of Humphrey Street and Atlantic Avenue), or 3) stripe the road for a Left Turn Only lane for north-bound traffic. *Continued from April meeting.*
  - b. Resident-Only Parking Request (Nason Road) – Request by AUDREE NORETT of 42 Nason Road to restrict on-street parking near the property to resident only, no allowance for visitors to nearby neighbors.
  - c. Removal of Unnecessary Handicap Spaces (190 Burrill Street) – Request by the DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS) to remove the on-street parking designation for handicap-accessible parking as the residents at the property may no longer need the restriction.
  - d. Pedestrian Crossing Signs (Humphrey Street @ Ingalls Terrace) – Request by EMILY CANTOR to place a vertical “Yield to Pedestrians” sign in the center of the Humphrey Street crosswalk at Ingalls Terrace.
  - e. Parking Lot Exit Signage Clarity (465 Paradise Road) – Request by the SWAMPSCOTT POLICE DEPARTMENT to look at the signage at the exit-only egress point of the Marshall’s property and determine if additional signage is needed.
3. Any other business that may properly come before the Committee.
