1. Review and approve minutes from previous meeting(s).
2. Traffic & Parking Regulatory Requests – items to be reviewed by the Committee in order to provide a recommendation to the Board of Selectmen.
 - a. Keep Right Island (Railroad Avenue & Pine Street) – The Board of Selectmen approved a temporary “island” to help properly regulate the traffic in the intersection. Being in place for over two months, the Committee will evaluate the effectiveness and report back to the Selectmen to determine if a permanent element is appropriate.
 - b. Discussion regarding traffic issues on Greenwood Ave., Bay View Ave., Cedar Hill Ter., Highland Street, and King Street – Request to review the potential of restricting the lower portions of Greenwood Avenue and Cedar Hill Terrace to one-way direction only during limited hours to reduce the amount of cut-through traffic that occurs at high commuting times.
 - c. Discussion related to crosswalks at intersection of Humphrey, Atlantic & Puritan. Resident raising issues about not enough notice to drivers creating a potential hazard in that intersection.
 - d. Discussion related to 34-36 Fairview and request to make a driveway public.
 - e. Request from a user on SeeClickFix to reinstate the “Keep Right” sign at the corner of Railroad Ave. & Pine Street, or installation of markers regarding that turn.
 - f. Concerns about parking on Monument Avenue.
3. Any other business that may properly come before the Committee.
