  - b. Request to enhance pedestrian safety on Paradise Road. Held over to this meeting to give Selectwoman Laura Spathanas an opportunity to address the committee.
  - c. Request to restrict Shaw Road to Resident Permit Parking only.
  - d. Request to place additional signage/walk signal for the crosswalk on Cherry Street. Held over for the Police and DPW to conduct a site visit and report back to the committee.
  - e. Request for no parking restriction on Shepard Ave. from driveway of 63 Shepard to a tree.
5. New Traffic & Parking Regulatory Requests – items to be reviewed by the Committee in order to recommend action by the Town Administration or to provide recommendations to the Swampscott Select Board for regulatory changes (if needed).
  - a. Further request from a resident of Franklin Ave. for to restrict traffic on Franklin Ave. to “one-way” only; and/or installing “calming strips” as a traffic calming measure.
