 - e. Request for no parking restriction on Shepard Ave. from driveway of 63 Shepard to a tree.

 - c. Request from resident that parking spaces on Burrill Street in front of the Library be marked, and for a 15minute parking restriction on one space to allow patrons to conduct quick visits, such as returning books, etc.
