2. Request for Determination of Applicability
 - **565 HUMPHREY STREET-BERTRAM HOUSE, (MassDEP File# TBD)** - Filed by Sarah Koch, for proposed work to build approx. 25 raised vegetable garden beds ranging in sizes , taking up approximately 78 cubic yards of space, wooden post and wire fence surrounding the garden measuring 240 Linear FT, a brick walkway from the sidewalk to the garden entrance measuring 112 sq. ft , and an ADA -accessible stone dust surface for all interior walkways, measuring 26 cubic yards at a 2-inch depth are proposed along the planting of 11 fruit trees, 24' x 26' addition on the west of the home that's on land subject to coastal storm flowage. Map 2709, Lot 21-1A-0.
 - **15 LAUREL ROAD-(MassDEP File # TBD)** -Filed by Margaret & Steven Copenhagen for construction of a new terrace, walkways, outdoor fireplace, fence and new plantings within 100 feet of an inland and /or coastal wetland resource area at Map 18, Lot 12-15.

 - **75 PURITAN ROAD, (MassDEP File #)** - Filed by Hayes Engineering, Inc for the proposed seawall construction and decorative retaining wall replacement, Map 21, Lot 21.
 - **179 BEACH BLUFF AVENUE, (MassDEP File#-TBD)** Filed by Wetlands & Land Management, Inc for proposed work occurring in the outer edges of areas mapped as land subject coastal storm flowage. The work includes the construction of a new garage, expanded driveway and parking areas, and a portion of a new in-ground pool, Map 31, Lot 38.
