### AGENDA

The Select Board and School Building Committee are holding this joint meeting to continue the important community discussion about a new elementary school for Swampscott. By the end of September, the School Building Committee will be narrowing the list of school options. Other town committees/boards have also been invited to this joint meeting to learn more about the school options and to provide feedback and ask questions. The meeting agenda will include the following:

1. Presentation by SBC and design team of elementary school options – followed by discussion
2. Presentation of financial implications / planning by Town Financial Team – followed by discussion
3. Discussion of re-use of Hadley School site in the event Stanley site option is selected and Hadley School deemed excess
