2. Traffic & Parking Regulatory Requests – items to be reviewed by the Committee in order to provide a recommendation to the Board of Selectmen.
  - a. Request for Stop Sign Installations (Salem Street) – Request by DAMON DEMADY to install stop signs (prior to entering Salem Street) at four street intersections (Harrison, Dennison, Linden, and Stanley). *Continued from March meeting*
  - b. Sidewalk Extension Concern (Humphrey Street) – Request by LISA SPINALE to look at the implementation of the sidewalk extension on Humphrey St at the intersection with Blaney St as it relates to parking and customer drop-off.
  - c. Request to Remove On-Street Handicap Space (86 Cherry Street) – Request by TRISHA MALPHRUS to remove the on-street handicap space in front of the residence as the user of the space no longer resides at the address.
  - d. Request to Add Yellow Double-Lining of Streets (Foster Pond neighborhood) – Request by CABOT DODGE to add double solid yellow lines at the intersections and curved roads in the neighborhood such as Foster Road, Windsor Avenue, and Burpee Road.
  - e. Request to Modify Traffic Signage (Laurel Road and Forest Avenue) – Request by ELIZABETH BURNS to reconfigure the signage that includes the street name, a "No Thru Traffic" sign, and a "Dead End" sign to better inform drivers.
  - f. Request to Improve Pedestrian Safety (Nason & Neighborhood Roads) – Request by MICHAEL CUCCHI to evaluate the intersection of Nason and Neighborhood Roads to better improve pedestrian safety and crossing with consideration for a sidewalk extension.
  - g. Request to Reduce Speed Limit to 25mph (Puritan Road) – Request by SUZY JONES to reduce the speed limit along Puritan Road to 25 mph.
