2. Traffic & Parking Regulatory Requests – items to be reviewed by the Committee in order to provide a recommendation to the Board of Selectmen.
 - a. Reduce Speed Limit to 25 MPH (Puritan Road) and Increase Enforcement – Request by RESIDENT to reduce speed limit along entire length of Puritan Road from 30 MPH to 25 MPH and to increase enforcement along the road. *Continued from November meeting*

 - d. On-Street Handicap Parking Space Request (Middlesex Avenue @ Clarke School) – Request by TRISH MALPHRUS to include an on-street handicap parking space at the elementary school. *Continued from November meeting*
 - e. Resident Parking Only Request (Suffolk Avenue) – Request by SHERMAYNE C. COLANTO to restrict on street parking on Suffolk Avenue to resident permit only.
 - f. Flashing Pedestrian Crossing Signal Request (Humphrey Street @ St. John's Church) – Request by POLICE CHIEF MADIGAN to install a flashing pedestrian crossing signal at the crosswalk on Humphrey Street in front of St. John's Church.
 - g. On-Street Parking Concern (Overhill Road) – Request by TONY WYMAN regarding on-street parking on Overhill Road during sporting events that limit access on street.
