The total square footage is 150,000 for the building

Are there any current issues with the skylights in the building.

Yes, they are deteriorating and at the end of their useful life. There have been leaks from them in the past and cracks in the plastic.

Will the greenhouse be part of the scope of the project.

Yes, renovations to the existing greenhouse will be part of the project as this is used a lab space for the 8th Grade Marine Biology Class.

When was the windows in the original portion of the school replaced.

The windows were replaced in the mid-90's and have acrylic exterior panels and glass interior panels. Plans for the replacement work are available for review

When was the heating system upgraded to the new boiler configuration.

That work was completed in the late-90's and consists of thirteen (13) small boilers and one (1) larger back up boiler. Plans for this replacement work are available for review.

When was the school converted.

The school was originally designed in the 1950's as a Middle School and was converted and added onto in 1977 to make it a High School. It was converted back to Middle School use in 2007, when the new High School opened.

Is there enough space to house the current student population in the building.

At this time there are no programmatic changes as part of this project.

Do the existing boilers as configured serve both the original building and addition as well.

The boiler room as configured serves the entire buildings heating needs for both the original and addition.

Is there a budget in mind for the construction and renovation of the school.

There is no budget for the construction and renovation of the school. As part of the scope of work of the assessment, we are asking that budgetary numbers be put together for each item so we can put a capital plan together.
