EARLY VOTINGE FOR NOVEMBER 6, 2018 STATE-Press Release

We are excited to announce that all registered voters are allowed to vote before Election Day, No Excuse needed! Early Voting will begin on October 22nd through November 2nd, 2018! Absentee voting is available for registered qualified voters who are: (1) absent from their city or town on Election Day, or (2) have a disability preventing them from going to the polls, or (3) have a religious belief preventing the same, are legally allowed to vote by absentee ballot.

Unlike absentee voting, early voting is for every registered voter. Registered voters do not need an excuse or reason to vote early. Regardless of whether a voter wants to take advantage of early voting, vote absentee or vote on Election Day, the first step is making sure you are registered. To check to see if you are registered to vote, and to find information on how to register to vote, you may visit the Secretary of the Commonwealth's website: www.sec.state.ma.us/ele. If you need to register to vote, you may do so online by visiting: www.RegisterToVoteMA.com. A valid license or I.D. issued by the Registry of Motor Vehicles is required in order to apply online. To be eligible to vote in the November 6th State Election, you must register to vote or make any necessary changes to your voter registration no later than October 17, 2018.
