4. Action items from last meeting's minutes

Verena thinks bigger issue are the fallen trees that looks bad. Would be good to get up there then replant some of the hill to make it nicer. TTF next meeting is April 12th.

Launch from historic commission website. Sammie Lawler sent a message about memorial apple tree. New schools – send web address to everyone for school

- 23. Develop map of areas for zoning regs to identify areas to limit negative impacts of land development- need a bigger discussion

- 24. Develop plan for replacement of ailing and aged street trees, ONGOING. 40K from town for tree planting went down waiting list, done with that by this spring. Planted 60-70 trees that people wanted. Now trying to get priority list together, where and what to prioritize, storm damage? Limited tree coverage? Next planting season will be fall. Verena: Key is tree inventory.
- 25. Educate coastal property owners that they should do something to protect their homes TONI Kleinfelder put together list, Molly put it in to brochure, some concommers want to tweak, work it in to site plan?? Almost check off! Toni sent a copy of the map to all.
- **7. High School Student** The principal has connected Brian with a student, Yaroslava, who has a solid resume, left it to meet & review, Tania also had Francie Southan of the Green Scholars reach out to her. They are putting together service project list. Ideas were suggested: Invite them to next meeting? Could they be a liaison to assist with better coordination? Their work doesn't have to be limited to one committee. Yaroslava

has attended a Conservancy meeting. Get involved with not only environmental issues but issues with how government works? Registry of deeds? We should let them know what we expect. Someone needs to be assigned as mentor. As a follow up, Brian and Toni both made suggestions for student projects.
