The meeting was called to order and the first order of business was to successfully approve the minutes from the March 25, 2021 meeting. The vote to approve was unanimous.

Discussion moved to the vote by SEC to approve the \$80,000 for Swampscott to begin the design and engineering for a new pier at Fisherman's Beach. The town will be providing the required 20% match. (\$20,000) It was suggested that it was time to bring more commercial fisherman into the discussion surrounding the new pier. How can the new pier be designed to suit their needs? One suggestion was to install a crane to help with moving gear to and from the fishing boats or help a sailor step their mast. We have since discovered that what we wanted was not a crane, which requires a licensed operator, but a hoist or davit which does not. Each member on the committee was then asked to prepare a list of wants and not wants for the new pier. We will compare our lists at the next meeting.

Whisky then updated the committee on the meetings of the Hadley School Re-Use Advisory Committee.

There was no public input, so the meeting was adjourned.
