TOWN MEETING PUBLIC OUESTIONS

The Select Board opened the meeting to questions from Town Meeting members.

- A Town Meeting member had a question regarding Article 13 and 14, inquiring if there would be a cell tower at the Machon. There was a discussion regarding the sidewalk by the Machon and the impact this has on traffic and benefit to the community.
- A Town Meeting member requested more information on Article 15 pertaining to Public Ways which Chair Peter Spellios and Town Administrator Sean Fitzgerald provided an explanation on the process.
- A resident requested information on Article 11 pertaining to the Seawall Repair
- Question about Harbor & Waterfront Plan Project. It was stated that the topic would be discussed in greater detail during Town Meeting.
- Question about Article 16 and minimum distance between multifamily buildings on different lots. Chairperson Spellios answered.
- Question about Town Meeting process and the difference between "recommend" or "report" which Mr. Spellios explained comes down to timing.

- Question about Acceptance of Public Ways is there an impact overall to other Town services by allowing the streets to become the Town's responsibility.
- Question about Article 12 and regarding the scope and difference between the cost of this article and the one placed on a previous warrant. It was clarified that this was not filed in consultation with the Building Dept.
- Questions clarifying financial terms (enterprise, free cash, revolving fund, stabilization)
- There was a question about the buildout at Town Hall
- There was a question regarding some zoning articles. Town Counsel, Attorney Tom McEnaney was present to answer.
