PUBLIC HEARING ITEMS

 Request for Determination of Applicability (RDA): Humphrey Street (various spots) – filed by Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority (MBTA). Request for determination of Wetlands Protection Act for improvements to Humphrey Street Bus Stops within 100 feet of an inland and/or coastal wetland resource (Map 1, adjacent to 34-56 Humphrey Street)

Natasha Vance and Tess Paganelli from the MBTA were present, along with Samantha Hogan and Katie Moulton from WSP Engineering.

MOTION: T. Bandrowicz to issue negative determination for project as defined, with the finding that work constitutes Land Subject to Coastal Storm Flowage, but will not have adverse impact. Commission to also propose alternate ground covers (i.e. plantings) instead of lawn. M. Lagerquist seconds motion; unanimously approved.
