THE APRIL 28TH TOWN ELECTION IS POSTPONED TO JUNE 2ND

Pursuant to Chapter 45 of the Acts of 2020 the Select Board voted on April 1st to postpone the April 28th Town election to June 2nd, with a stipulation that they will revisit this on May 4th. It is possible the June 2nd Town election could be postponed again to a later date all depending on COVID-19.

On April 1st the Select Board also voted to postpone the May 18th Annual Town Meeting to June 22nd.



Due to Chapter 45 of the Acts of 2020, all registered voters have the option to request an early voting ballot through the mail only for the town election. Simply complete an application then mail to Swampscott Town Clerk's Office, 22 Monument Avenue, Swampscott, MA 01907.

An Absentee ballot application will also be acceptable for Early Ballot requests. If you already completed a 2020 Absentee ballot application for "All elections this Year" OR "April 28th election" with the Town Clerk's Office you do not need to file another application, a ballot will automatically be mailed to you.

Early Voting or Absentee ballot applications can be mailed, E-mailed or deposited in the 24-hour drop box just outside the main Town Hall entrance.

There will be polling hours on election day however due to COVID-19 all voters are urged to vote by mail to maintain social distancing. Once a voter has cast an early voting ballot, the voter may no longer vote at the polls on Election Day.
