***Who is eligible:** Anyone 18 years of age and older that meets the eligibility criteria to get a booster dose:

- They are at least 18 years of age <u>and</u> it has been at least 5 months after the final dose in the primary series

 OR –
- Adults ages 50+ can choose to receive a second booster at least 4 months after their first booster
- For those who received the J&J/Janssen COVID vaccine:
 - One booster dose is recommended at least 2 months after the first dose of a J&J/Janssen COVID-19 vaccine
 - Anyone who received a J&J/Janssen COVID-19 vaccine for both their first dose and booster may receive a second booster at least 4 months after their first booster
 - Adults ages 50+ can choose to receive a second booster at least 4 months after their first booster, regardless of what type of booster they received

Remember:

- You <u>must</u> wear a mask when getting vaccinated
 - Please wear a short-sleeve shirt
