




Yard Waste

The Swampscott Health Department would like to remind residents of the curbside yard waste collection dates on your regular trash day.

Acceptable material includes grass, leaves, and brush trimmings up to 1 inch thick. Unacceptable material includes dirt, stumps, thicker tree branches, and loose trash debris.

Material must be placed in yard waste bags or barrels labeled "yard waste" and be out for collection by 7AM on your collection day. Yard waste placed out in plastic bags will not be accepted. Bags or barrels of yard waste that are too heavy (over 50 lbs. each) will not be accepted.

Yard waste must be on the sidewalk or in front of your property line – close to the street. The contractor cannot go onto your driveway or lawn or other private property area.

We are having conversations with the contractor to ensure all yard waste, properly placed out, will be collected within the weekly time frame as required.

Yard Waste Stickers are available at Town Hall Customer Service.

Learn more about her life – how she went from having no interest in cooking to becoming one of the culinary legends of all time.


The audience will have the opportunity to view Julia on the set of The French Chef television show, an amusing and fun experience!


