What is mesothelioma?

Mesothelioma is a rare and aggressive form of cancer that is caused by the inhalation or ingestion of microscopic asbestos fibers. These fibers become lodged in the mesothelium, the membrane that surrounds the lungs, abdomen, and heart. Over time, these fibers cause cells to mutate and form tumors. There are three forms of mesothelioma cancer: pleural, peritoneal, and pericardial.

Because the military relied heavily on asbestos as an insulator and for fire protection, veterans make up over a third of all mesothelioma cases diagnosed each year. The proliferation of asbestos in military ships, vehicles and hardware caused millions of veterans to be exposed without ever having been provided any safety gear or precautions.
