- Vote for ONE BOARD OF ASSESSOR member - 3 Year Term
- Vote for ONE SCHOOL COMMITTEE members - 3 Year Terms
- Vote for ONE TRUSTEE OF THE PUBLIC LIBRARY member - 3 Year Term
- Vote for ONE BOARD OF HEALTH member - 3 Year Term
- Vote for ONE PLANNING BOARD member - 5 Year Term
- Vote for ONE HOUSING AUTHORITY member - 5 Year Term

Each Candidate for Town-Wide Office will also be required to fill out Campaign Finance forms, both eight days before the election and thirty days after, as well as an end of year
