Discussion ensued on individuals to be invited to the upcoming stakeholder interviews; and three focus groups, with a decision that one group would be community members under 55. Potential group and individual names will be added on Slack.

Regarding a draft Mission statement, Margaret Somer and Peter McNerney volunteered to develop a draft for the group.

Regarding related events, a 5/1/19 Cape Ann event was noted, as well as a 6/26/19 AARP event. Also a 6/15/19 Nutrition Day and a 6/21/19 Alzheimer's Awareness Day.

Merging some of the many Domain subcommittee was proposed and approved, to be followed up with later action.

Transportation for seniors - possible changes were noted to expand from The Ride to experimenting with Uber and Lyft.

The status of the Age-Friendly Application was noted.

The Committee will skip meeting in July/August. The Needs Assessment is expected in September, at which time Domain groups can write their Domain Action Plans.
