

## **TRAFFIC STUDY ADVISORY COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES**

1. Introductions – Chair Linda Hayes opened the meeting with a welcome and introductions.
2. Public Comments – William DiMento spoke against resident only parking for Pine Street. He stated that the VFW was not in support of the plan, as members and guests use Pine Street for parking.
3. New Business
  - a. Traffic calming/signage on Pine St- SPD monitored the speed limits on Pine Street from September 2 to September 22 and found that there were approximately 2,200 cars that traveled on Pine Street during that time. Average speed was 23mph; 90% of cars drove less than 30mph and 10% drove greater than 30mph. Police will provide additional traffic enforcement and DPW will install speed bumps.
