

TRAFFIC STUDY ADVISORY COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

MEETING LOCATION: VIRTUAL

April 7, 2022, 9:00 AM

1. Introductions – Chair Linda Hayes provided welcome remarks and introductions.
2. Public Comments – Resident followed up on Beach Parking signage (Phillips Beach area) and suggested that the committee recommend an increase in parking fine for parking in resident parking areas. The current fine of \$25 is not a significant deterrent for parking by beachgoers as that is less than parking fees at area beaches.
3. New Business
 - a. Pine St resident parking only from Erie to New Ocean –after a discussion on the merits of resident parking this item was tabled due to planned redevelopment of 12-24 Pine Street.
 - b. Stetson relocation of speed board to between Franklin & Barnstable – SPD will relocate the speed boards once data has been downloaded.
 - c. Burpee resident only parking from Essex to Jessie/discussion of resident access to Jackson Park- Resident only parking for Burpee Road was discussed during the rehabilitation of the Machon School. Currently, congestion and double parking appear to be a regular occurrence on Burpee Road. Sections of Burpee Road will have no parking signage updated near connecting roadway corners, and by Machon as requested in agenda item “d”.
 - d. Burpee no parking from #17 to #53 or Jackson Park – post to Jackson Woods. This request was unanimously approved.
 - e. Review draft proposal re: speed bumps & traffic- to be reviewed in the future.
4. Old Business
 - a. SPD update re enforcement of speed & traffic violations on Paradise Rd near Family Doctor. SPS provided an update on number of violations.
 - b. Speed bumps/tables draft policy -under review by G. Archer and B. Isler.
