In partnership with the Department of Public Works & Forestry Division of the Town of Swampscott, this commemorative program encourages the planting of trees in municipal land to honor a loved one or notable event.


Planting a tree benefits the health and beauty of Swampscott. Your thoughtful gift will be admired for generations to come.

Trees are an emblem of life and death. A cycle of planting, growth, and eventual passing. They benefit communities not only aesthetically but by cleansing the air, mitigating flooding, and providing food and shelter for wildlife. Trees are an indispensable part of our community & landscape.

How to Participate

In return for your tax deductible contribution of \$350 for an ornamental or canopy tree, the town will purchase, plant, stake, mulch, water and maintain this new tree during its normal life. A replacement tree will be provided if the tree is lost within two years.

Process



1. At the discretion of the Forestry Division and Department of Public Works, tree selections and planting locations are chosen based on species and appropriateness for placement. A list of approved tree species and open locations is available. Donors may provide preferred species and locations, if any, on their application and the town will review the availability and feasibility of the choices.

2. Trees can be purchased any time; however, planting will only take place in the Spring or Fall. Trees are normally 1.5"-3" in diameter, depending on nursery stock and species.

Based on specific location and for an extra cost, a bronze plaque can be installed.
